NOTE 4

In 1998, Merrill Lynch nominated Joseph LaStella for “Entrepreneur of the Year” for his work in creating zero emissions vehicles.

NOTE 5

In 1994, Michael Okerlund Leavitt Governor of Utah (also former US EPA Administrator and currently Secretary of Health and Human Services) declared a Zero Emissions Day in Utah and presented Joseph LaStella with an honorary plaque for his company's contribution to electric vehicles. That same day, Governor Leavitt requested to personally test drive Mr. LaStella's electric vehicle around Salt Lake City with Mr. LaStella as a passenger and the Governor's limousine following the car. At the same time, four other electric vehicles chauffeured Capitol Hill assembly members around town.
